



Slavery/Human Trafficking Policy

Introduction

Billcole Haulage (Stevenage) Limited acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the organisation. The company is opposed to all forms of unlawful and unfair discrimination, human trafficking or slavery and will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The term "slavery" describes forced or compulsory labour and includes child labour.

The term "human trafficking" under the act includes commercial sexual exploitation, forced marriage, or the extraction of organs or tissues. However, within this policy document, human trafficking relates primarily to the trafficking of humans for labour purposes.

This policy statement relates to actions and activities during our financial year and is reviewed on an annual basis.

Policy

Billcole Haulage (Stevenage) Limited does not condone the concept of Slavery, Human Trafficking or abuse of human rights and will not tolerate its practice within the organisation. BHL requires our supply chain to embrace the same philosophy and communicates this requirement to our suppliers. Any supplier who is found to (or suspected of) engaging in any form of slavery or human trafficking shall be reported to the appropriate authorities. BHL shall terminate the business relationship with any supplier found directly guilty of such practice. BHL shall assist suppliers where possible to help eradicate any slavery practices uncovered within their own supply chain.
